Each year, MSCO honors an organization or individual who has made a significant contribution in the area of cancer care and treatment, patients' rights, or cancer education. Past Audesse Award winners include The Ellie Fund, The Joe Andruzzi Foundation, Lois Green, the Melanoma Foundation of New England, Conquer Cancer Coalition of Massachusetts, Senate President Robert Travaglini, Susan G.
